

Death or Incapacity of a Therapist

At a recent meeting of the UKCP's College of Hypno-Psychotherapists (CH-P) it was agreed that the following will apply to CH-P members:

In the event of your death or incapacity, your family/friends may not be the best people to liaise with outstanding, potentially vulnerable clients. You should, therefore, have an arrangement in place with an experienced therapist so that they can access details of your clients. The therapist can then make contact and offer appropriate support and advice.

To ensure compliance with the above, you will be asked to include the name of your nominated therapist on the NRHP renewal form.

It is considered a measure that may benefit clients and could take pressure off bereaved family and friends.

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
